Access Card/Swipe Card: These will be collected from us at the start of your placement. If your card is lost or you fail to return it at the end of placement you will incur a £25 admin fee.

Access to Education Centre out of hours: Your swipe access badge will give you access to the Education Centre 24 hours a day. After 6pm the Education Centre is alarmed, the only areas not alarmed are the ground floor corridor, Library, Common Room and toilets and you are welcome to use these.

Absence –On the first day of absence you must complete a Student Absence Reporting Form online; this can be found on SharePoint. Please also contact Bath Academy and your CTF so that we're aware of your absence. ruh-tr.bath-academy@nhs.net

Accommodation: A bottom sheet and 1 pillow are provided but you need to **bring your own duvet and duvet cover.**

To report any issues with accommodation please email the Academy team **ruh-tr.bath-academy@nhs.net** and quote the name of the accommodation block, room number and the number on the blue disk outside of the bedroom/bathroom/kitchen e.g. Gloucester House, 1B1, 09 0 003..

Security: Please call **01225 824890 (ext. 4809 on an RUH phone)** if you require security. For out of hours accommodation issues , call the switchboard on 0 and ask for the Oncall Estates Officer.

If you have an emergency outside of office hours, please call the switchboard on 0 and asked to be put through to security. We do not take a deposit for your key but if you lose it, there will be a charge of over £40 to replace it. For security purposes, please make sure you lock the entrance door to your flat when you leave.

Bikes: There is a secure bike shed situated next to the Education Centre. Your swipe card will allow access to this. Please do not take your bike into the accommodation under any circumstances.

Buses: Take the No: 4 from the main entrance for the town come approximately every 15 minutes – either Odd Down or Bath Bus Station on the front.

Car Parking: Students can apply for an 'out of hours' parking permit but are strictly not allowed to park on-site during working day.

Common Room: Coffee and tea are provided for you for free, just help yourselves. Please bring your own cup as we do not provide them. It would be much appreciated if you would keep the room tidy and clear up before you leave. The code to the common room is C1627.



Doctor: Please call Newbridge Surgery 01225 425807, they are situated on Newbridge Hill a 5-minute walk from the hospital. You will need to register with them before they offer an appointment, but this won't be a problem, they're used to seeing our medical students.

Dentist: If you need an urgent dental appointment, ring 111 and ask for a local NHS Dentist.

Health and wellbeing:

Physio: We offer a self-referral physio service here at the RUH. For more information, please contact Becky, Annette or Kerry.

Counselling: We offer a free and confidential counselling service via EAP our Employee Assistance Programme. You can contact them yourselves without having to let us or Bristol know. Their number is 01225 825960/824484

Sports:

The **swimming pool** is situated in the Oasis, opposite the Education Centre which you are entitled to use free of charge. It is open May – October and there is an on-line booking system. <https://bookwhen.com/ruhswimming> the discount code for students is XXXXXX. We also have **squash and tennis courts** on site which you can book using the same link above.

Launderette: There are 2 launderettes. One in Buxton House near Gloucester House, door code: C162XZ and Bernard Ireland House go to Entrance C, use the code C5671Z walk through the door ahead of you and the launderette is on your right-hand side.

We have had two new washing machines installed this summer, the costs are:

Wash: £3.50

Dry: £2.00



Library: Situated within the Education Centre on the ground floor. The library is open 24 hours. There are banks of computers at the back of the room which are yours to use, just log in with your Bristol details. They are linked to a printer which is free to print.

If you order something from Amazon, please choose the click and collect option and ask it to be delivered to the RUH. The Amazon lockers are located in the corridor by the Friends restaurant.

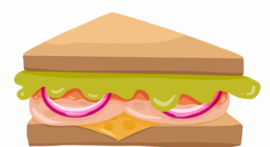
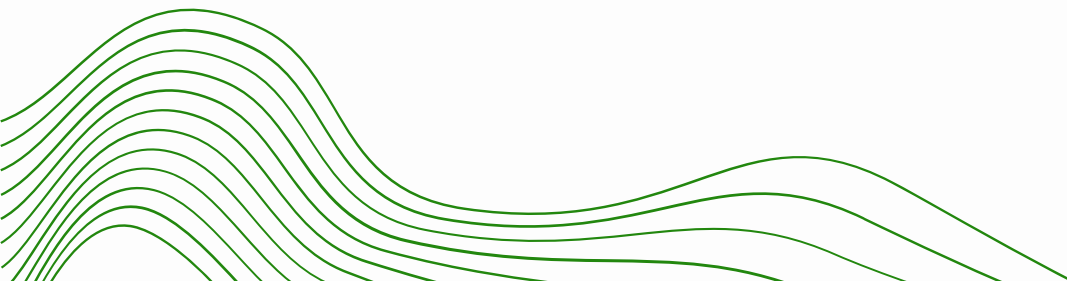


Personal Safety: If you are staying on site and need to be escorted back to the accommodation late at night, please bleep 7655 and request that a Security Guard walks back with you, there might be a wait if they are already out on-site.

Hospital food and drink: The Lansdown Restaurant is situated in the main corridor of RUH South where there is a good selection of sandwiches and meals. There is a discount if you are wearing your badge. There is a restaurant/snack bar in the Atrium. The Friends new coffee shop is on the ground floor zone B and the Oasis opposite the Education Centre sells great coffee.

Spiritual Care Centre: this replaces the former Chapel. The Centre offers 24-hour access for people of all faiths or none, providing room for reflection, prayer or simply to gather their thoughts.

Members of the chaplaincy team are always available as a listening ear when required. We have a quiet room for confidential and sensitive conversations. Ablution and prayer spaces are available for Muslim staff or Patients and their Families. You are encouraged to make use of our courtyard sculpture garden with seating for a restful and peaceful environment.

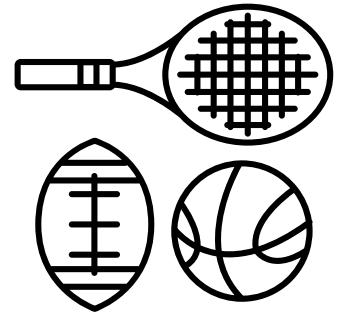

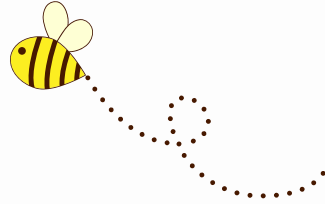
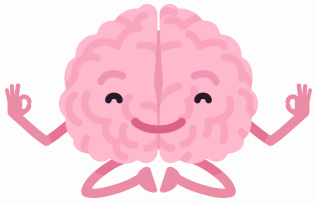


Festivals in Bath
